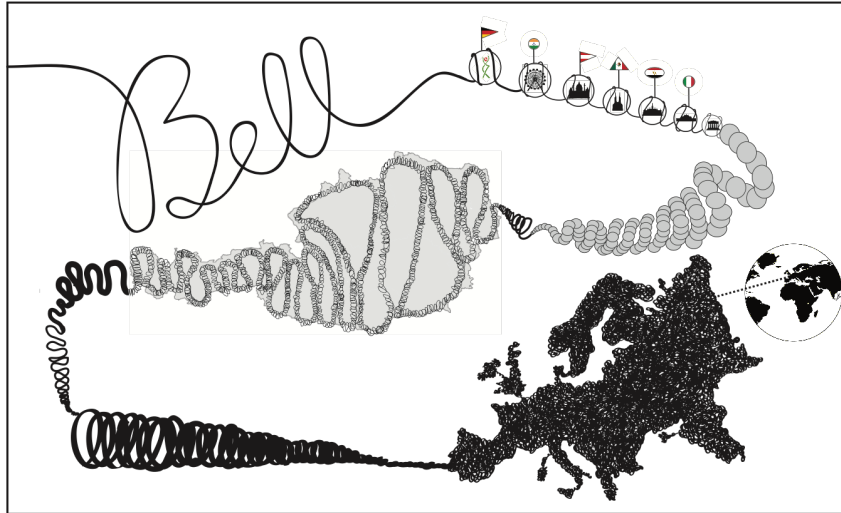


MSc position in Epigenetics

We are looking for a highly motivated student with interest in Epigenetic Gene Regulation to carry out her/his MSc thesis in the lab of Oliver Bell at IMBA - Institute of Molecular Biotechnology in Vienna. The project aims to dissect the molecular mechanisms underlying inheritance of heterochromatic gene silencing in mouse embryonic stem cells (ESC) and neural stem cells (NSC). Our lab combines synthetic biology approaches with state-of-the-art technologies including CRISPR genome editing and Next-Generation Sequencing. In addition to a good foundation in molecular biology and solid understanding of gene regulation, we are looking for an enthusiastic team player ready to break new ground in epigenetic research.
